


iTapPad Quick Tutorial

This quick tutorial covers the non-iPhone version of iTapPad. The iPhone version works in a similar manner with a few modifications to make it more usable on the iPhone.

Registration

Before you access the great features of iTapPad, you need to create an account. In the upper right corner of the main page, click on the **Register Your TapPad** button. Then fill out the registration form.

Once your registration is complete, you will be sent an e-mail (that hopefully is not blocked by spam filters). This e-mail will contain a link that will activate your account. After your account is activated, you are ready to start designing your TapPad.

Logging into iTapPad

If you already have an account, you can log into iTapPad from the main page.

You only need to log in to edit your TapPads. For viewing your TapPads from your iPhone, you will have a specific URL that will allow you to use your TapPad without logging in.

Retrieve Your Password

We all forget our passwords every now and then. If you forgot your password, click on the **Forgot Login** button on the main page.

If you do not remember your account name, you can get your account information e-mailed to you.

If you remember the User Name, Last Name and E--Mail address you used to register your TapPad, you can instantly retrieve your login information by using the **Retrieve Password** form. If you do not remember everything, you can submit your E-Mail address, we will send you your password. (This only works for e-Mail address we have on file.)

Managing your TapPad

Everything from this point on is accessible **ONLY** after you log in to iTapPad.

Editing Your User Information

After your account is created, you can edit any information in your user profile. Click on the **Profile** icon.

User Name
Password
Password (again)
E-Mail Address
First Name
Last Name
All fields are required.

DESIGN IT, LOAD IT, TAP IT

Your user name must be unique.

Designing Your TapPad

To design your TapPad, click on the **Designer** Icon. The TapPad Designer is divided into three main areas.

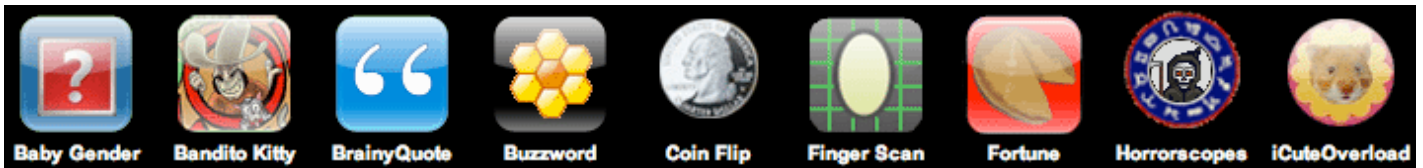
1. TapLink selection
2. TapPad Manager
3. TapLink Edit Area



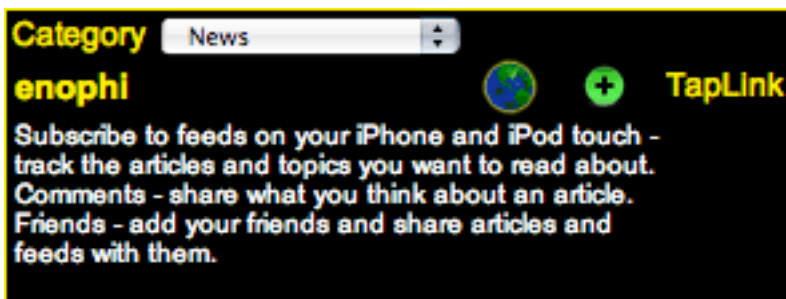
Adding a TapLink

The TapLinks are separated into many categories. There are over 500 TapLinks to choose from so displaying all of them at once would be hard to navigate.

Select a **Category**, the TapLinks for the selected category will appear in a scrolling list.



From this list of TapLinks, click on the **TapLink** you are interested in adding to your TapPad. At the left of the list, a brief description of the TapLink is shown.



If you click on the **Earth** icon, a new window will open with the web page for the TapLink. Clicking on the **Green Plus** will add this TapLink to your TapPad.

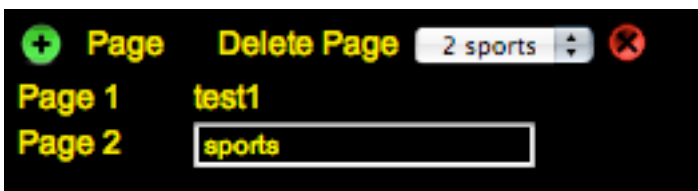
Managing Your TapPad



You can view your TapPad pages by using the **Page** tabs at the bottom of the TapPad Manager.

Managing Your TapPad Pages

To modify, add or delete a TapPad page, click on the **PAGES** tab.



Adding a New Page

Click on the **Green Plus** and a new page will be created. You can have a maximum of 10 pages.

Deleting a Page

Select a page to delete in the **Delete Page** menu. then click on the **Red X** to delete the page. The first page cannot be deleted.

Changing a Page Name

Enter the name in the edit field next to the page you want to rename. The page name will update when you leave the Page Manager, add another page or delete a page. The name of the first page cannot be changed.

Editing a TapLink

Click on the TapLink in the TapPad Manager that you want to edit. The TapLink Editor will appear in the Editing area.

Delete a TapLink

Click on the **Red X** to delete the TapLink

Display Name

The Display Name is the name that will display under the TapLink icon in your TapPad. You can change this to anything you want as long as it is less than 20 characters.

Tap To

This determines what happens when you tap on your TapLink, You can send it to the URL, have it dial a phone number or navigate to another TapPad page.

URL

This is where you enter the URL of the site. If you want to dial a number, enter the phone number here.

Click **Update TapLink** to save your changes.
